**Footnotes**

TOCCET had good early speed outside, angled in and prompted the pace outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, battled between horses nearing midstretch, fought back inside KAFWAIN to regain a short advantage a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. KAFWAIN off a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a foe, advanced three deep on the second turn and four wide nearing the stretch, came in some entering the lane, put a head in front three wide in midstretch, battled gamely outside the winner through the final furlong but could not quite match that one late. DOMESTIC DISPUTE pulled a bit early, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. COAX KID three deep into and on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came out some into the stretch, steadied sharply in tight entering the lane and weakened. ROLL HENNESSY ROLL sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, fought back into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. LOGICIAN between horses early, settled off the rail chasing the pace and did not rally. Following a stewards' inquiry, KAFWAIN was disqualified and placed fourth for interference entering the stretch.
