TEXAS GLITTER dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, inched away leaving the bend and gamely held under a strong hand ride. FULL MOON MADNESS chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and closed gamely to just miss. ECHO EDDIE also chased inside the runner-up but off the rail, angled to the fence for the turn, split horses into the stretch, bid along the rail in the drive and continued willingly to the wire. RAMPAGING ALF settled along the inside, came out into the stretch but could not offer the needed late response. MR LIGHTFOOT (IRE) a bit slow into stride, was unhurried toward the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. RUDI'S PET (IRE) off a bit awkwardly, settled outside a rival and failed to menace. BAY RUNNER had good early speed and dueled inside the winner, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
