Footnotes

CARDINAL ZIN broke slowly, chased inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained the lead, inched clear under urging and held gamely. PROCESSOR'S TURF chased off the rail then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. OPTION chased between foes then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, split rivals in midstretch and rallied between foes late. ZETTERBERG stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, was carried out some between horses in midstretch but also finished well. SANGAREE stalked off the rail then between foes on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, also was carried out between rivals in the lane and lacked the needed late kick. STRIP MINE settled off the rail then angled in, continued along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished. SCREEN TO SCREEN dueled outside a rival, drifted out between foes in the stretch and weakened. BANDEIRA UNION chased outside then three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, was carried out in the drive and did not rally. MASTER DANIEL dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch, came off the rail in the drive and weakened late. SODA POP KID broke slowly, angled in and settled inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. ALONZO slow into stride, settled off the rail then angled in on the turn and did not rally. ROUGH IDEA wide early, chased outside then alongside a rival leaving the turn, split horses into the stretch and weakened.
