**Footnotes**

FEVERISH angled in and dueled on a short lead toward the inside, fought back outside the runner-up into and on the second turn and through a long hard drive and gamely prevailed under strong handling. GOURMET GIRL saved ground stalking the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, bid along the rail and took a short lead into the second turn, dueled inside the winner the rest of the way and also continued very gamely to the wire. LAZY SLUSAN stalked the pace between horses on the first turn most of the backstretch, continued off the rail, came out into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. CRITIKOLA (ARG) broke to the inside, awkwardly and slowly, settled a bit off the rail, moved up on the second turn, continued toward the inside in the stretch and finished well. SPEAKING OF TIME saved ground, dropped back on the backstretch, cut the corner into the stretch, came out in midstretch and improved position. KENTUCKY STORM off a bit slowly, settled outside, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. SAUDI POETRY chased outside a rival, advanced three and four wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response on the stretch. COOKIN VICKIE angled in and forced the pace outside the winner, dropped back between horses on the second turn and weakened. MAGIC CODE close up stalking the pace three deep, also dropped back on the second turn and had little left.
