NATALICAT tracked the dueling leaders early from the three path, angled into the four path in the turn, took over command in the stretch and drew clear late. ARONIA stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn but did not have enough late. BREAN CAN dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. LINDA'S LACE was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch. PRINCESS COMPOSER was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn with no late bid. BONO QUEEN dueled early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. WATCHIN SENORITA was done early.
