DUCKY'S ICE CREAM stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. MOCC ME NOW set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. NOBLE DEVIL was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. THERESNOJUSTICE tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. LOW GAP angled into the three path in the turn while no threat. LIL ALBERT E. angled into the five path in the turn while no factor. VERY CLEAR raced up close early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch. O'CHARLIE had brief speed then retreated.
