CHIEF TALKEETNA broke awkward from the gate, was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and drove past the leader late under a steady drive. PALM SPRINGS pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but yielded late. REVERENTIAL dueled early while on the inside into the turn, took over in the stretch but faltered late in the drive. LIL PERFECT STORM dueled early, led the field briefly, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. FLAT OUT RICH raced up close early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. FATHER ART angled into the four path in the turn while no threat. WIN AGAIN was done early. BAR HARBOR showed little.
