LETEM FLY set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and prevailed in the final stages. JACKS ARE LUCKY broke awkwardly from the gate, chased the early pace, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. MOONSHINE STILL tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch run. SPURTABILITY stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late. CALL IN ADVANCE raced up close early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. EQUINE BEAUTY was never a threat. BULBRUSH was done early. OUR LUCKY SOX was never involved. HUSTLIN JOE showed little.
