U HUSH was bumped at the start then tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command and drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. BARRY K was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn with a belated gain in the stretch run. TUFF COOPER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch. POSH'S FAIRY TALE was bumped at the start then chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. STEVIE THE LIAR stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. CALABASH was never a threat. RAMA raced up close early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and was empty in the stretch. SPUNKY BREWSTER was never involved. RUBADAR was done early. TOUCH TRADITION showed little.
