Footnotes

FINDING TIME settled just off the pace along the rail, steadied and angled out nearing the turn, advanced between rivals around the bend, angled back inside in midstretch and steadily closed along the rail under right-handed urging to get up in deep stretch. SLIVER was unhurried while racing three wide through the opening three furlongs, swung five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and rallied through the lane. LIL CON MAN prompted the pace three wide, took command nearing the five-sixteenths marker, edged clear in upper stretch and led until the final strides. CROWN'S BIG DAY chased the pace four and five wide and rallied mildly. GEORDIE set a pressured pace in the three path and weakened in the drive. MUDD TRACKER lacked speed, raced five wide around the turn and made a mild belated rally. SUNSET ARTISAN stalked the pace inside and came up empty in the lane. MAJOR POINT failed to menace while racing five wide. STREAK O GREY was never a factor while racing along the rail. DR. JASPER pressed the pace two wide between rivals and tired after a half.
