RODS RUNNING REDD prompted the pace two wide, took command near the three-eighths pole and drew off under a drive. BALTERSAN was caught four wide around the first turn, advanced four deep around the far turn and finished willingly to gain the place. JAYDEE lacked speed inside, advanced four wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. HEZA WINNER TOO was unhurried while racing three wide, moved up while still three wide around the far turn and made a mild stretch gain. THURBEN rushed up four wide around the first turn, bid three deep outside of the winner around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. LIGHTNING JACK stalked the pace two wide and lacked a rally. BUDGET BARGAIN saved ground and never factored. KEELBACK lacked speed, raced three wide around the far turn and improved his position in the lane. TWO STASH stalked the pace from the rail and dropped back after a half. HOOSIER EQUAL set the pace along the rail, was collared near the three-eighths pole and faltered in the lane.
