TRICK O MAN set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then repelled bids and drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. JADENS RUNNER tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and was no match for the winner in the stretch run. SHORT SALE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. BENJI BLUES stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. COMING ON pressed the pace early from the inside, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch. DO DAT TUNE was never a threat. LIL CON MAN was done early. OSCEORO had early speed then retreated. MAJOR POINT was unprepared at the start and outrun. EVOLVING showed little.
