MANX MISS settled off the duel down the backstretch, advanced four wide around the far turn, closed under stout left-handed urging, swept to command in deep stretch and won going away. SHE BE SMOKIN dueled four wide down the backstretch, edged clear leaving the three-eighths pole, held clear past the eighth pole but could not resist the winner in the final yards. IDEALHOUSE was outsprinted early, advanced in the five path around the turn and finished willingly to gain the show in the final strides. HIDATSA dueled along the rail, could not match strides with the winner from the three-eighths pole, drifted out under intermittent left-handed urging in the final eighth of the mile and lost the show in the final strides. SHERRY'S TIGER failed to menace while racing two wide. SARATOGA FLING dueled three wide between rivals down the backstretch and tired. I. D. THE MOON was never a factor while racing inside. BLONDE BULLET vied two wide between foes down the backstretch and gave way entering the turn.
