**Footnotes**

BAHIM settled off the pace along the rail, edged closer around the far turn, swung five wide at the head of the lane, quickly moved into contention, reached near even terms at the eighths pole, drove clear and dug in to hold off a late charge from the runner-up. TIMBER WILDCAT raced within range in the two path, swung six wide nearing the quarter pole, rallied through the lane but could not quite reach the winner. SOONER SHAKER chased the pace inside, angled out in upper stretch and rallied for the show without threatening the top two. GREEN N GOLDIE was in tight just after the start, lacked speed and rallied belatedly. LUCKY CHANCE set the pace along the rail, shortened stride in upper stretch, continued on his left lead, was collared near the eighth pole and continued to fade. HURRICANE DENTON was never a factor while racing along the rail. DEETS broke in a tangle, raced four wide around the turn and lacked a rally. INDY GO SUN failed to menace while racing three wide. REPENT AND REJOICE chased the pace two wide, came four wide into the lane and weakened. TIME ADOSIOUS broke inwardly, pressed the pace two wide, faltered in upper stretch and was eased through the last furlong.
