Footnotes

DARLIN' DIANE chased the pace, raced five wide around the turn, began an advance leaving the three-eighths pole, closed steadily, took command near the sixteenth pole and drove clear. MOVE ME UP stalked the pace four wide, lugged in near the three-sixteenths pole, stayed inside past the eighth pole, dropped back while sharply swinging out near the sixteenth maker and finished strongly to gain the place. MAYA'S MYSTERY set a pressured pace between rivals down the backstretch, dueled outside of DANCEWHILEITSTORMS past the eighth pole, could not resist the winner near the sixteenth marker and held second until the final stride. DANCEWHILEITSTORMS dueled inside of MAYA'S MYSTERY past midstretch and gave way grudgingly. SILK AND LACE was off a step slow and never a factor while racing off the rail. EMBELLISHED GOLD chased the pace from the rail and tired in the lane. KENTUCKY GAL prompted the pace three wide down the backstretch and steadily faded after a quarter-mile.
