MAKIN' BACON MAN trailed the field early, while on the inside into the far turn then angled to the outside in the stretch run and rallied while driving past the leaders and clearing the field late. HUNTING FOR DIABLO tracked the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the far turn then took over command in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. PRIAPUS set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. RAILROAD ROY was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. SHAGGY MCPHEE angled into the four path in the far turn while no threat. BENAMINBABINS was on the inside into the far turn and had no rally. SON CHARM was unprepared at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent. THE BOY FROM ROY had early speed then folded up. SINGING CHAMP had brief speed then retreated.
