GARNET CRYSTALS chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and split horses late while driving past the leader in the late stages. FACEY'S SPIRIT set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then drifted in and out during the stretch run and yielded in the final stages. LUNE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. LIL MISS SMARTY K angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. BROWN RECLUSE was done early. FEET FLEETING FAST bobbled at the start and was outrun.
