GIVHANS FERRY was settled in the early going then rallied four wide on the turn, was in a strong drive then drew away in the end. SONG GIRL was well placed while racing three wide into the turn, made a bid to gain a slim lead in mid stretch but came up empty in the end. PLAY SOLEIL pressed the pace while racing on the inside, rallied to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch then weakened in late stretch. LUCYGOTGAME was unhurried early then moved out to be five wide for the stretch drive, made a late rally but was no threat in the end. RUSTICANA was allowed to settle and racing on the inside but failed to menace in the stretch. PLEASE BE DISCREET raced five wide into the turn and was no factor. SLACKER set the early pressured pace then was two wide on the turn, was used up and gave way in late stretch.
