TIME TO GETIT stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and prevailed in the final stages. HOLD'EM OR FOLD'EM set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. NEVER FORGET pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but yielded late. BULLNOSE BRICK was unprepared at the start, angled off the rail into the turn with a mild bid in the stretch run. WILL E SCAT chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch. COUNTY CLERK moved up in the stretch. IN SESSION was through after a half. G AREYOUKIDDING had brief speed then retreated. THE RIDER OF NEVER FORGET CLAIMED A FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF TIME TO GETIT FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RUN BUT IT WAS DISALLOWED.
