Footnotes

PAWS PRINCE stalked the pace from the rail around the first turn, angled out to advance down the backstretch, bid three wide around the far turn, reached near even terms in upper stretch, dueled outside of JACKS ARE LUCKY through the stretch and edged ahead in deep stretch to prevail in a game effort. JACKS ARE LUCKY set the pace in the two path, dug in when confronted by the winner in upper stretch, dueled inside of that foe to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. MO FASTER stalked the pace from the rail, angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly. VERY CLEAR was caught four wide around the first turn, raced two wide between rivals around the far turn and lacked the needed rally. MAGIC ROCK stalked the pace three and four wide and faded in the drive. SAFARI KID failed to menace while racing five wide throughout. SHARI BOMB never threatened while racing four wide. RARE POWER lacked speed inside, raced three wide around the far turn and never factored. K LO'S LUCK was three wide around the clubhouse turn, angled to the rail down the backstretch and never threatened.
