CLASSICAL RHYTHM was well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn, rallied in the stretch and edged past the leader late under a steady drive. MR. SASS broke thru the gate pre-st, set the pace early while on the inside into the turn, drew clear in the stretch but was caught late. PUT UP OR stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. PURPLE SUTHERLAND tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. CENTRE ISLAND broke awkward from the gate and steadily faded. DIATONIC was never a threat. JIM'S DEPUTY broke awkward from the gate and was outrun.
