Footnotes

JUNE'S BEST pressed the pace four wide into the turn, moved to the two or three path to chase the pace into the lane, quickly moved by that one after straightening in the lane then widened. SAILORS PASTTIME moved up along the inside through the turn, got closest to the winner inside the eighth pole then was all out to last for the place spot. MISS ZIGGY was outrun for half while near the inside, rallied through the lane then missed place while never a threat to the winner. PLENTY O LADY was near the rail into the lane and moved up. NELL'S ENJOYMENT bid from the seven path into the lane then leveled out. HIGH ON TOP set the pace into the lane then gave way outside the eighth pole. VICK'S VIOLET pressed the pace early while three wide then faded. POTLUCK PRIZE was in the four path through the turn and tired in the drive. ESSENCE OF TIME pressed the pace into the turn while in the two path then faded. PITDINKLE SLEW was in the four path through the turn, came widest into the lane and was never in it.
