GOLDEN BULL set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn with a long drive in the stretch and held in the final stages. SOME KINDA TROUBLE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but missed late. STELLAR HOPE pressed the pace early while three wide, angled into the three path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. HE'S RISING tracked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn and weakened late in the stretch. TIGER STRIKE was never a threat. HONOR MATTERS was well placed early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. ITS MR. CAT TO YOU was through after a half. WESTERN BANDIDO was always outrun.
