THE NEW BUCKETLIST pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and edged clear in the late stages. RICHARD HART set the pace early then steadied in the turn, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole and came again in the stretch but did not have enough late. MY PRIZE NOW was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. TEXAS HOLDEM JOE was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch run. GLOOMY GUS was unprepared at the start then rushed up into the contention from the rail, was getting out into the turn and was tired late in the stretch. LOOKS LIKE A SAINT angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. VALUE THE GREYBIRD was done early. STORM CURRENT was never a factor. UR UP ZIP showed little. QUIET SENSATION was through after a half.
