Footnotes

RIDIN' WILD stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn while still three wide then was in a long sustained drive in the stretch to take command and drew away in the end. SALTY JURIST set a pressured pace while inside, was in a long drive then dug in throughout the stretch but weakened in late stretch while holding the place safe in the end. PATRIOTIC DREAM was well placed while inside, saved ground on the far turn while making a bid but came up empty in the stretch drive. BLUEGRASS JAM was unhurried early while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a mild rally on the far turn then was no menace in the stretch drive. ELLIO chased the early pace while two wide, was used up and faltered. EL SOMBRE raced three wide on the backstretch, was used up and gave way. WHERE'S THE BEEF was hard to load then raced three wide on the backstretch and lacked a rally in the stretch drive.
