Likewise, for older horses where the weight allowances and step allowances from the claiming price result in a weight less than 118 lbs. the weight to be carried will be adjusted to 118 lbs. BILLIONS BOY set a well handled pace from the start, drew off in mid stretch and was kept to task in the end while clear. MOONBLAST was three wide on the run down the backstretch, rallied on the turn then moved out to be four wide for the stretch, dug in gamely and was up for the place in the end. COMMANDEER chased the pace while three wide, made a bid on the turn then came up empty in late stretch. CHARMING ENDEAVOUR broke a step slow then was hustled along to be in contention but was used up and faltered. FANCY TRAIN was saving ground on the turn then made a bid but came up empty in the drive. CHAMP KAMAL was four wide on the turn and outrun. MOUNT RAZMORE was inside on the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch.
