LADY HUNTINGTON tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. WHITNEY LAKE dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. ALY STORM chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch. MOR THAN THE REST dueled early from the inside, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. ALI THE GREAT angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. BRASH CALICO was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but was empty late. WIDEEYEDRACHEL was never a threat. OCALA BARBIE was unprepared at the start while no factor. MRS. T was done early.
