JAYDEE trailed the field early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. EVANS THUNDER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch but was ran down late. SWEEP THE CODE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. GROOM HIS DEVIL angled into the four path in the far turn and ran evenly in the stretch. CAPTAIN STYLES was through after a half. MILTONSHARPSHOTER had early speed then folded up. STAMP IT IAN threw head at the start and bucked off the rider.
