Footnotes

PASS THE CROWN pressed the pace two wide, reached even terms nearing the five-sixteenths pole, quickly drew clear when roused right-handed in upper stretch and continued to widen under urging through the lane. COMING ON chased the pace five wide around the turn, came six wide into the lane and rallied for the place. NORTHERN REVEAL stalked the pace two wide between rivals, could not keep pace with the winner in upper stretch while moving into a clear second, failed to switch leads and weakened in the last sixteenth. LORD AVIE JONES stalked the pace three wide between rivals, came five wide into the lane and weakened. I SEE A SHARK lacked speed three wide and passed tiring rivals. FERDIE'S GOT IT failed to menace while racing two wide between foes. BRENT THE BANKER was never a factor while racing along the rail. KASH THIS CHECK faded along the rail. HE'S SMOKIN' set a pressured pace just inside of the winner, faltered in upper stretch and was eased late.
