BRICKYARD chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then drew off in the stretch under a brisk drive. CHOW WAGON was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn then moved up in the stretch but was no match for the winner. SPIRITUAL ORDER tracked early then took over command, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. GUNNER was back early, angled into the three path in the far turn and improved position late. NORTHERN CANDYRIDE was well placed early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. ARROSON had early speed then retreated. OAK RICH had brief speed then folded up. UNBRIDLED DISTRESS was done early.
