Footnotes

MR. REALISTIC trailed the field early, angled into the three path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leaders in the final stages. JOHNS LION set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn with a long drive in the stretch but yielded in the late stages. SPEED LIGHTNING was widest into the first turn and while along the backstretch, tracked the pace, angled into the four path in the far turn and continued to bid in the stretch but hung late. DREAMING FREE (VEN) angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. INDY GO SUN swung into the six path in the far turn while no threat. BARAT pressed the pace early from between horses, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch drive. PHEASANT LANE vied for the lead early, angled off the rail into the far turn and steadily faded throughout.
