CONCHACER set a pressured pace from the inside from the start, was headed in upper stretch then responded with a strong surge and proved best in the end. MOE MAN was stalking the pace while racing three wide into the turn, rallied in upper stretch, was gaining ground while three wide and finished well but was too late. GRAND TRAVERSE pressed the pace while two wide from the start, gained a slim lead in upper stretch between calls then dug in gamely throughout the stretch drive but came up empty in deep stretch. MUHAASEB raced two wide on the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. DOINMYSONGNDANCE hit the gate at the start then broke in a tangled, was inside on the turn but was no factor in the stretch.
