Footnotes

BRASSWICK dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn, shook away late in the stretch under a steady drive. SPURTABILITY was well placed early, while on the inside into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. BULBRUSH was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. SWEET LITTLE DIXIE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with no late gain in the final stages. MORTENSEN dueled early while on the inside into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. ASK SIDNEY angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. MISS ASHLEY had early speed then faded late. MO GUSTO raced up close early, was getting out through the turn and soon retreated.
