OUR DEVIL'S HALO pressed the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn, angled out in the stretch and drove past the leader late. PORT ROYAL TEE dueled early while on the inside into the turn, led in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. LUCKY CHUCK was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. MAN FROM MARS tracked the pace early, led the field briefly, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. TUERTO was well placed early, steadied in the turn and faded late in the stretch. YOU ALREADY KNOW trailed the field early, swung into the six path in the turn and improved position late. MR CONSOLIDATOR was through after a half. CLIFF'S BEST BET was done early while wide throughout. TUNA TISCH was never involved. TWO PENS KEN had brief speed then folded up.
