LIVING BREAD chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. LORD AVIE JONES pressed the pace early from between horses, angled into the four path in the turn then continued to bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. JUSTATHOUGHT set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. FLAT OUT RICH was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch run. HAARMAN vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. BRASS BOLT angled into the five path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. STORMIN FERDIE altered course through the turn around fallen foe. FATHER ART broke down.
