FOR REGISTERED INDIANA BREDS FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NEVER WON TWO RACES. Three Year Olds, 117 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a race at a mile or over since July 15 Allowed 2 lbs.

Claiming Price \$5,000. Pursuant to IHRC Rule 71 IAC 7.5-3-4 subsection 1, in races prior to September 1 all three year olds entered to run against older horses, where the weight allowances and step allowances from the claiming price result in a weight of less than 116 lbs. the weight to be carried will be adjusted to 116 lbs. Likewise, for older horses where the weight allowances and step allowances from the claiming price result in a weight less than 118 lbs. the weight to be carried will be adjusted to 118 lbs.

JOWILMA G chased the pace while inside, saved ground on the far turn making a bid but was no match for the winner in the stretch. COLADA LOVE was unhurried early then rallied two wide on the far turn, was gaining ground but was no menace in the stretch. PRETTY PAULINE chased the pace while racing two wide, was used up then faltered. ALI THE GREAT was three wide on the backstretch then failed to respond. ACCORDINGLY ANN was outrun.
