LAZ HAS RISEN stalked the dueling leaders early from the outside, angled into the five path in the far turn, edged clear late in the stretch under a steady drive. SISYPHUS chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. RIDGELAND AVENUE dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. CRAIG'S TYLER was back early, swung into the six path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. BLUE HEAVEN was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn but couldn't sustain the bid in the stretch run. MARKSMILK IS WHITE angled into the five path in the far turn while no threat. INCREDIBLEE was through after a half. STORM THIS dueled early then soon retreated.
