SONGLYRICS set a well handled pace from the start, drew off in mid stretch then held sway in the end in a confident ride. A UNIQUE LADY was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while five wide, stayed five wide for the stretch drive and closed fast but was too late in the end. INDIANA RUTH was settled then rallied four wide in upper stretch making a bid then came up empty in late stretch. HOOSIER HOTTIE saved ground heading into the turn, made a bid then raced evenly in the stretch drive. ACT COURAGEOUS was unhurried early and failed to menace. TERESA'S ROSE pressed the pace while two wide into the turn, was used up and gave way in the stretch. TEN TUTUS raced three wide into the turn and was no factor. MABEE MONK raced wide throughout and was no threat. DOG TOM was used up in the early going and stopped in the stretch.
