### Footnotes

MARDI GRAS PARTY steadied shortly after leaving the gate and trailed the field early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leaders while clearing the field in the final stages. DAMION E. T. was well placed early, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch and was up for place late. OCK MAN chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened and lost place late. T. L. SENSATION set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. HEBE'S PRIDE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late. NEW YORK GIN tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then had no room in the top of the stretch and soon faded. SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKEY was through after three quarters.
