JOE'S KEEPER chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a brisk drive. THEQUESTIONIS tracked the pace early while three wide, angled into the four path in the turn and was no match for the winner in the stretch. FAITH DELIVERED dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. RAGING WATER stalked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and was empty in the stretch run. HUNTING FOR DIABLO angled into the three path in the turn and improved position in the stretch. HARTMANS KOMET dueled early from between horses, angled into the three path in the turn. BOND KILLER was never a factor. COULD BE MICHAEL showed little. STRINGMAN was done early.
