RICHARD HART tracked the pace early while three wide, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and cleared late. JAXSON BE GOOD was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn then altered course inside the three sixteenth pole with a late rush and was up for place. GLOOMY GUS stumbled at the start then stalked the pace early while four wide, angled into the four path turn then led in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. TRIPLE TRANSFUSION was back early, angled into the three path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch run. CONSUMED bobbled and was bumped at the start then dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. FAST HOOSIER broke in at the start and dueled early from between horses, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. BUDGET BARGAIN was never a threat. ORIENT FORTY broke out at the start and was bumped off stride. SHINEY was done early. DEACON CRONE stumbled at the start and was outrun.
