KING SNAKE pressed the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. BRIAN'S PEAK stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn while no match for the winner in the stretch run. LAST DEMAND chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. JOHNNY CADILLAC was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. EXTERIOR fanned into the seven path in the far turn and improved position. BIG BAD BLUE was never a threat. GRACIAS DERENZO was done early. DANSEURS NOBLES set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch. BALLACOLLA had brief speed then retreated.
