REVERENTIAL tracked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then took over command and drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. CONCERT KING was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. TREASURE HUNTER stalked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and weakened late. B L'S PAPA COO COO stumbled at the start then vied for the lead early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and faded late in the stretch. SPEEDY MEDIA angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. FAST EDDIE CHARLES dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch. B L'S TSUMANI was done early. STRONG AS STONE broke awkwardly from the gate then dueled early and retreated late.
