BRIAN'S PEAK was well placed early, angled into the three path in the final turn, took over command in the stretch and drew off late while being ridden out. GREY T GIFT set the pace early, angled off the rail into the final turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. BALLACOLLA raced up close early, angled into the four path in the final turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch. NEEDARUNNER tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the final turn and faded late. THIRD DAY had early speed then retreated.
