WATTS FERRY brushed with BARE'N DOWN just after the start, set the pace along the rail and held sway under a drive. ROMAN DICTATOR stalked the pace three wide, had dead aim from the head of the lane but could not go by. CELTIC EXPRESS lacked speed, angled inside to save ground around the turn, angled back out leaving the sixteenth pole and rallied for the show. DALAMAR was fractious in the starting gate, was quickly angled out into the five path, was unhurried while racing four wide around the turn, started to make progress under left-handed urging in upper stretch, lugged in under right-handed urging in mid stretch and flattened out on his left lead. BARE'N DOWN brushed with the winner just after the start, prompted the pace two wide and was out kicked in the lane.
