FOR REGISTERED QUARTER HORSES TWO YEARS OLD THAT REMAIN ELIGIBLE BY QUALIFYING WITH THE TEN FASTEST TIMES IN THE QHRAI 2011 SSA FUTURITY TRIALS. Weight: 122 lbs. This stake will be limited to ten starters, all of which qualified with the fastest times in the Auction Futurity Trials. Purse distribution will be: 39% to the winner, 19% to second, 9% to third, 7% to fourth, 6% to fifth, 5% to sixth, 4.5% to seventh, 4% to eighth, 3.5% to ninth and 3% to tenth. Enter at the usual time of entry as listed in the condition book. Assistant starters will be supplied for each competitor. A negative coggins and health certificate issued within the past 30 days for out of state horses and proof of herpes vaccination within the past 6 months must accompany each horse. Note: The trainer is hereby agreeing to the rules defined in Indiana Code 71 IAC 8.5-2-5 and 71 IAC 8.5-3-4.
