DON'T PUT IT BACK set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. JEMARU was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch and held place in the final stages. CLASS READY was well placed early then had to alter course around foe in the turn, angled into the five path inside the quarter pole with a late gain in the stretch run and just missed place. GOLD FOR CASH tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. MY FEVER angled into the four path in the turn and improved position. ROSSCAT was through after a half. SOLD OUT was done early. DA SUGA MAN had to alter widest in the turn around pulled up foe. HEWILLGLITTRNSHINE was pulled up and vanned off.
