JOHNNY CADILLAC was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the far turn, rallied in the stretch then drove past the leader and cleared late. SEATTLE GIN pressed early, took over the lead, angled off the rail into the far turn, drew clear in the stretch but yielded late in the final stages. COUNTRY BOY WIT tracked the pace early while on the inside into the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. SULTRY PLEASURE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. SWERVE was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn and lacked a late bid. ZARBIT angled into the four path in the far turn while no threat late. MY THIRTY SIX was never involved. GATOR GAS showed little. DEDIRECT had early speed then folded up.
