BULLNOSE BRICK was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. SHALE SHAKER was back early, while on the inside into the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drew clear but yielded in the final stages. WING A DING was far back early, swung into the six path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out in the drive. WAR ENSIGN hopped at the start, while on the inside into the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. BAR HARBOR set the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and gave way in the stretch. BELLO VICTORIO stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. BEARIFIC was through after a half. MARKSMILK IS WHITE was well placed early, angled into the five path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch.
