Footnotes

MAUI STORM stumbled at the start, vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn, took over command in the stretch and shook clear late under a steady drive. STORM THE BEACH was back early, while on the inside into the turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. SECRET ACCOUNT was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn and flattened out in the stretch drive. LIKETHATONLYBETA dueled early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch. DANCE MAN dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. LINE EURO chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and lacked a late bid. ROBYN THE TILL angled into the three path in the turn while no threat. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE was done early. HANG ON PEPPER showed little. NEW YORK PROSPECT was never involved.
